

Thomas Township Parks & Recreation Youth Soccer Rules Spring 2014

All Divisions

This is a recreational program and no standings are kept. The object is to learn about soccer and sportsmanship while having fun.

Hands can only be used by the goalkeeper or a player throwing in the ball from an out of bounds call by a referee.

Each team is allowed 2 time outs per game. Time outs are one minute long.
No slide tackles.

We will call Off Sides in the 4th-5th-6th grade division.

K—1st Grade League (Y5”s)

Players: 7 v 7 and one goalkeeper (if a team does not have 8 players the umpire will decide how many players will play)

Coaches: 2 coaches from each team may be on the field with their team to make communication easier

Play: Play is divided into four 8-minute quarters
Half time is 8 minutes
Quarter breaks are 4 minutes

2nd—3rd Grade League

Players: 7 v 7 and one goalkeeper (if a team does not have 8 players the umpire will decide how many players will play.)

Coaches: 1 coach from each team may be on the field with their team to make communication easier

Play: Play is divided into four 12-minute quarters
Half time is 8 minutes
Quarter breaks are 4 minutes

4th—5th—6th Grade League

Players: 7 v 7 and one goalkeeper (if a team does not have 8 players the umpire will decide how many players will play.)

Coaches: No coaches are on the field during the game

Play: Play is divided into two 26-minute halves
Half time is 8 minutes
