

## Enjoy Our Parks

Thomas Township has four beautiful and unique parks, plus two trails for enjoying the outdoors. Each park is owned, operated and maintained by Thomas Township Parks and Recreation.

ROBERTS PARK, 455 S. MILLER Paved pathways; 3 soccer fields; 4 softball diamonds; 3 pavilions; fishing pond; and play area. The park continues to expand as grants and monies become available.


**ROETHKE PARK, 400 LEDDY ROAD:** 1.57 miles of natural scenic beauty seen from chipped and natural rustic quiet trails; bandshell; miniature train rides; pool; play areas; and fishing pond.

DAY PARK, 700 S. RIVER: Two picnic table pavilions, sledding hill; and open space.

**COMMUNITY PARK, 249 N. MILLER:** Two full size basketball courts; a roller hockey court; and two ice skating rinks.

THOMAS TOWNSHIP TRAIL begins on Shields Drive: the 2.6 mile lineal park heads south, skimming the edge of Swan Valley High School, entering James Township and eventually connecting to the Saginaw Valley Rail Trail and is home to the annual Thomas Township Trailblazer 5K Run/Walk. The park continues to expand as grants and monies become available.

SAGINAW VALLEY RAIL TRAIL covers 9.55 miles of abandoned rail corridor in Saginaw County. It stretches from Saginaw to St. Charles and incorporates seven bridges, the Shiawassee State Game Area and numerous rivers and creeks. The trail offers an equestrian trail, trail shelters, restroom facilities, viewing platforms and benches. Owned, operated and maintained by Saginaw County Parks and Recreation, this trail can be accessed from the Thomas Township Trail on Stroebel Rd., Van Wormer Rd. and Water Street in St. Charles.






### Run for Windy 5K Race


