### Parks & Recreation FYI

#### **Registration:**

Each camper will need to register for camp at the Thomas Township Parks and Recreation Office. Registration is limited and will be taken on a first come, first serve basis until filled.

#### Payment:

Payments may be made by cash or check only. Please make checks payable to Thomas Township.

#### **Drop-Off Information:**

Campers are to be dropped off and picked up at Roethke Park Depot (400 Leddy Road).

**DAY camp** drop off time is no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick-up time is no later than 4:15 p.m.

**MINI camp** *drop-off time is no earlier than* 9:45 a.m. and pick-up is no later than 3:15 p.m. There will be additional fees for early arrival and late departure from camp.

**Parents/Guardians** are responsible for signing their children in and out of camp EACH day. Campers will not be released unless signed out by proper parent/ guardian.

#### **Before and After Camp Care**

For your convenience, we will be offering before and after camp care for regular DAY campers (<u>not offered during MINI camps</u>). This service will be an additional \$30/child per week. Your child **must be** pre-registered for the before and after hours services.

This is designed to be a more independent experience for your child. During before & after care, campers are permitted to bring in books, gaming devices, snacks, etc. for their entertainment. The use of these items will not be permitted during normal day camp hours and camp is not responsible for these items.

Campers can be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. and picked-up by 5:30 p.m.
