Day Camp:

MINI Camp:

 - Monday through Wednesday 10 a.m.-3p.m.
 - Dates: July 1st 3rd
 - *There is no before/after care or field trip for mini camps*

Before and After Camp Care

Before and After Camp Care for regular DAY campers (not during MINI camps) will be offered. Your child **must be** pre-registered for the before and after hour

services.

During before & after care, campers are permitted to bring in books, gaming devices, snacks, etc. for their entertainment. The use of these items will not be permitted during

normal day camp hours and the township is not responsible for these items.

Campers can be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. and picked up by 5:30 p.m.

Drop-Off Information:

Day Camp - drop off time is no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick-up time is no later than 4:15 p.m.

Mini Camp - drop-off time is no earlier than 9:45 a.m. and pick-up is no later than 3:15 p.m.

Campers are to be dropped off and picked up at Roethke Park Depot (400 Leddy Road).

Parents/Guardians are responsible for signing their children in and out of camp EACH day. Campers will not be released unless signed out by proper parent/ guardian.
