

WHAT IS DAY CAMP

Each of our camps are designed to build self-esteem while promoting self-confidence and leadership. Our daily programs encourage children to participate in activities that will help them grow socially and physically while interacting with other children and making new friends!!!

Day Camp:

- ◆ 8 weeks of Camp for children ages 7-12.
- Monday through Friday 9am to 4pm

MINI Camp:

- ◆ 1 week of camp for ages 4-6.
- Tuesday through Friday 10 a.m.-3p.m.
- Dates: July 6th - 9th
- *There is no before/after care or field trip for mini camps*

We have different themes each week. All crafts, games and snacks during the week will reflect that theme. Not only is this exciting and fun for kids, it is also an educational experience.

Children will be able to use their creativity while making crafts, participating in adventurous games and contests, getting exercise while swimming at the pool, being able to catch fish in the Roethke Pond, and even experience an off-site field trip most weeks.

Drop-Off Information:

Day Camp: Drop off time is no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick-up time is no later than 4:15 p.m.

Mini Camp: Drop-off time is no earlier than 9:45 a.m. and pick-up is no later than 3:15 p.m.

Campers are to be dropped off and picked up at Roethke Park Depot (400 Leddy Road).

Parents/Guardians are responsible for signing their children in and out of camp EACH day. Campers will not be released unless signed out by proper parent/

MINI CAMPERS NEED TO BE POTTY TRAINED TO COME TO CAMP

Before and After Camp Care for regular DAY campers (not during MINI camps) will be offered. Your child must be pre- registered for the before and after hour services.

During before & after care, campers are permitted to bring in books, gaming devices, snacks, etc. for their entertainment. The use of these items will not be permitted during normal day camp hours and the township is not responsible for these items.

Campers can be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. and picked up by 5:30 p.m.
