INFORMATION AND GUIDELINES

1. Amount of scholarship – Up to three \$1,000.00 scholarships given annually. The committee, at their discretion, may award more than three scholarships. The amount will be equal, but not less than \$500, for each student in any selection year. The total amount awarded in any given year may not exceed \$3,000.
2. The scholarship will be given to:
 - a. Any high school graduate or G.E.D. equivalent who resides within Thomas Township.
 - b. First consideration will be given to those in financial need or entering a public safety or health care field.
 - c. All information submitted will be considered confidential.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION

1. The official Thomas Township Scholarship Application must be filled out and submitted.
2. The candidate must have earned a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better. A copy of the most current high school transcript must be included.
3. Applicant must be a resident of Thomas Township
4. Individual interviews may be conducted with each of the final candidates by the selection committee.
5. Two letters of recommendation must be included; letters from emergency service or medical care personnel are encouraged, one must be from a school representative.
6. The recipient must be pursuing or planning to pursue undergraduate, graduate, or job skills at an accredited university, college or a recognized trade school.
7. The candidate must complete a proper application for the scholarship within two years of graduating from high school or within two years of receiving GED.

SELECTION COMMITTEE

The selection committee will consist of members of the Thomas Township Fire Association Scholarship Committee.
