



Kluck Nursery

One of the long standing businesses in Thomas Township is Kluck Nursery. Started in the 1920's , Walter Kluck began by planting a couple of acres of evergreens as a "dig your own" nursery while operating a full time dairy farm. Two sons, Edward and Gerald operated the business, with Gerald's son Tom joining in 1981. After the retirement of both Edward and Gerald, Tom is now the President of Kluck Nursery which now has roughly 400 acres of shade and ornamental trees, evergreens and landscape plants.

The business which employees forty people, seven of those being Michigan Certified Nurserymen, specializes in landscape plant material. They also offer a landscape design service and delivery.

In the fall the nursery has an open house with special discounts available on plant material and a chance for you to tour the tree fields and select your plants.

A memorable "family tradition" can be made in December when the "chose and cut" Christmas tree fields are open. For eighty years Kluck Nursery has been providing an opportunity for families to get together and select that special Christmas tree (about 4,500 each year) while enjoying a hay ride, a warm fire, concessions and lots of photo opportunities. Each tree is put on a shaker to remove excess needles and baled for easy transport. Pre-made wreaths are available for purchase as well, along with beautiful "kissing balls".
