DESCRIPTION OF CATEGORIES USED FOR REGISTRATION AND JUDGING

- 100 Float-Professional:** Large commercial businesses, Festival floats, etc.
- 200 Float Amateur:** Local business, churches, clubs, etc.
- 300 Sports Car:** Any type sports car
- 400 Antique Car/Truck:** Pre 1950 vintage
- 500 Classic Car/Truck:** 1950 to present
- 600 Special Interest Unit:** A "unit" not a float, representing a business, church group, club or group, such as: old trucks, locomotives, animal outfits, groups of people, etc.
- 700 Musical Unit:** Any musical group, marching, on a vehicle, or on a device pulled by a vehicle
- 800 Marching Unit:** Cheerleaders, Pompons, Drill Teams, etc.
