Thomas Township Public Safety Building, 8215 Shields Drive, Saginaw

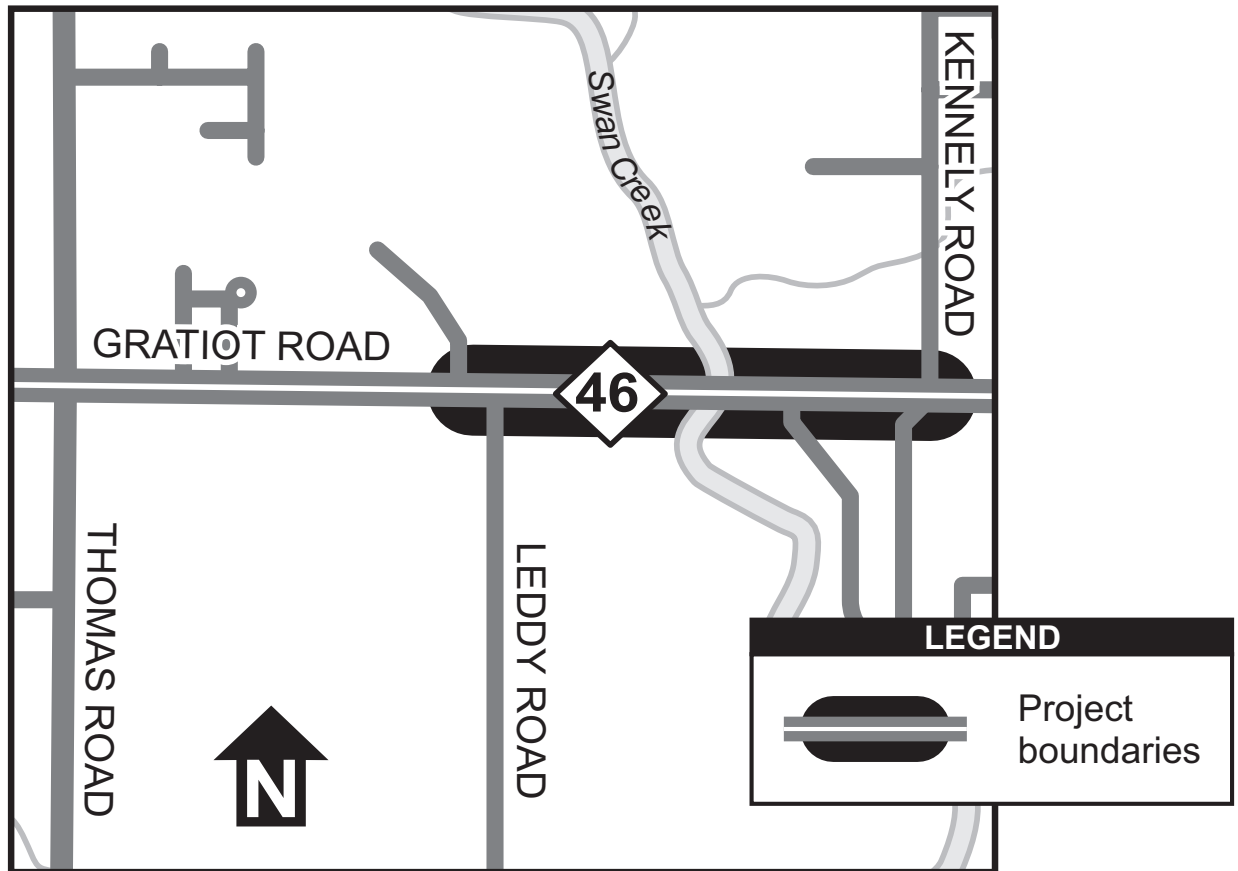
This meeting will provide an opportunity for the public to meet with Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) staff and ask questions about road and bridge improvements along M-46 (Gratiot Road) from west of Leddy Road to east of Kennely Road in Thomas Township, Saginaw County.

Work includes removing existing median crossovers and constructing indirect left turns/crossovers, as well as bridge work over Swan Creek that includes resurfacing, structural steel repairs, painting, substructure repairs, erosion

countermeasures, and road approach paving. Construction is expected to begin on Monday, April 20.

Interested residents, businesses, and community representatives are invited to stop by anytime during this open house-style meeting to learn more about the project. MDOT staff members will be available to answer questions.

The proposed project will benefit motorists by enhancing safety and extend the life of the Swan Creek Bridge.
