Presentations:

A. Morgan Court Extension

Mr. John Morey of D&M Site was present along with Josh Kemerer to discuss their plan submitted to extend Morgan Court (located in Winchester Farms) and split the parcel of land for development. The plan shows five (5) parcels all meeting the required frontage for development. Mr. Morey did note that the intention is to have this be a public road and they will be verifying dedication of the storm sewer as part of the Roenicke Drain in order to do so. Mr. Iamurri did question one of the contingencies and asked who will be responsible to take care of the cul-de-sac island area of the proposed extension. Mr. Josh Kemerer stated he will be building on one of the parcels and would take on the responsibility of maintenance of that area. Mr. Sika did explain to the Planning Commission that since this involves the extension of the roadway, once the Planning Commission makes their decision it will go before the Thomas Township Board for final approval in January.
