

REFUSE GUIDELINES



RECYCLING

- One bundle of brush is allowed each week and must be bundled. Branches can only be 3-4 feet in length and at least 2" in diameter.
- Residents no longer <u>need</u> to set out at one official recycling bin.
 - Recycling bins may still be used if residents choose.

MMWA will promote the use of any 45

- gallon or smaller container/can(s) for recycling.Non-recycling containers need to be
- labeled with Recyclables Only stickers or paint a large "R" on the can.
 Recyclable bins may be purchased at the
- Thomas Township Office for \$7.00 each. Yard Waste & Recyclables stickers are also available.



HOLIDAY EFFECTS ON REFUSE COLLECTION

- When a major holiday falls on a weekday, collection will be delayed one day. Holidays that fall on a Saturday or Sunday do NOT affect collection days.
- Information regarding trash pick up during holiday weeks is normally found in various local papers as well as at the Thomas Township website, www.thomastwp.org. You can also contact *Mid Michigan Waste Authority* by calling (989) 781-9555 or the Thomas Township Office at (989) 781-0150.



REFUSE COLLECTION IS ON FRIDAY IN THOMAS TOWNSHIP

- Trash *must* be placed at the curb by 7:00 am on Friday. Materials not placed out by that time will not be picked up that week.
- You may have an unlimited number of bags or cans of household generated trash each week. However, trash must be in bags or cans that are no larger than 35 gallons and should not weigh more than 50 pounds each.

YARD WASTE

- Yard Waste collection is provided from April through November.
- Yard waste is defined as grass clippings, yard vegetation, sod without dirt, twigs (less than 2" in diameter) and leaves.
- These items need to be placed in 35 gallon or smaller cans or paper yard waste bags weighing 50 pounds or less. If you are using a can it must be labeled with a **yard waste** sticker which are available at our Township Office.

SPECIAL COLLECTION ITEMS
