# WHAT IS DAY CAMP?

## Drop-Off Information:

**Day Camp:** Drop off time is no earlier than 8:45 a.m. and pick-up time is no later than 4:15 p.m.

Campers are to be dropped off and picked up at Roethke Park Depot (400 Leddy Road).

Parents/Guardians are responsible for signing their children in and out of camp EACH day. Campers will not be released unless signed out by proper parent/guardian.

Before and After Camp Care will be offered. Your child must be pre-registered for the before and after hour services.

During before & after care, campers are permitted to bring in books, gaming devices, snacks, etc. for their entertainment. The use of these items will not be permitted during normal day camp hours and the township is not responsible for these items.

Before and after campers can be dropped off as early as 7:30 a.m. and picked up by 5:30 p.m.

This service will be an additional \$30/child per week.

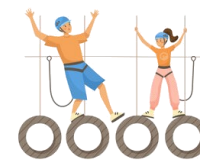
### 7/22 - 7/26 Nature Unleashed
