8. *(DeLine)* What would you hope to accomplish as a Board Trustee if you are selected to fill the vacancy?
9. *(List)* How do you handle differences of opinion?
10. *(McDonald)* If selected, will you run for the position in 2028 when the appointment expires?
11. *(Monahan)* How familiar are you with the scope of Thomas Township's operation? Explain.
12. *(Witt)* Are you available for Monday evening meetings and other committee meetings?
