- 9. New Business:
 - A. Parks Director Corriveau informed the Park Commission of the potential purchase of land owned by Wash World. The parcel is .09 acre located west of the Nature Center & Preserve. A pole barn would be built for the Nature Center. Once a signed offer is received, The Spicer Group will survey the property and the land will be assessed. Discussion followed regarding design and location of driveway.

 - A. Parks Report
 - <u>Roethke Park</u>: Thirteen, dead Jack Pine trees were removed between the Depot and the garage. A large Cottonwood tree was also taken down that was lifting the concrete pad at Pavilion #1. Roof bids are due Friday, April 28th. Additional topsoil work will need to be completed at the old waterfall site.

- Roberts Park: Our Spring Soccer Program and Flag Football Programs have begun and our first games will start on April 29th. We have thirty soccer teams and twelve football teams this season. Maintenance crew has dragged the ball diamonds, bases are out and the fields are fertilized. Crew will begin to remove the outfield fences in preparation for the Rebel Co event this next week. The construction for three new Sand Volleyball courts has started. Staffing shortages for games is a concern and is the lowest in years.
- <u>Community Park</u>: Pickleball nets are up. Parks Director Corriveau is currently fundraising an estimated \$250,000 for six new Pickleball courts and one tennis court to be built at Roberts Park.

- **Sports & Programs:** Registration for Day Camp and Swim Lessons are open. Spring Soccer & Flag Football will start on April 29th.
- Nature Center Preserve: Nature Center Coordinator Lynda Thayer presented an update on construction of building and landscape. Electrician needs to complete work by April 30th. New windows, drywall, metal & Dura-last roofing, furniture and displays are all in progress. Plants and seeds are coming. The tree removal of Siberian Elm was completed by Monk's Tree Service. A grand opening for the Nature Center will be in two phases. Tentative dates for the preliminary/private ribbon cutting ceremony will be on August 24th and a grand opening for public is proposed for August 27th. Parking is limited and a shuttle service will be provided.
