Mrs. McCoy mentioned that the gateway signs east, and west set the outer edge of the district and a water feature will be in the center to make the area more notable. The water feature will most likely be used 7 months of the year from May to November each year then winterized. The DPW will most likely make a lighted Christmas tree display over it during the winter months.
