#### A. Review and approve bids for Gateway Sign West Landscaping

A discussion took place about the bids for the Gateway Sign West Landscaping. Tri-Valley came in with the lowest bid at \$3,943.68. The board has full confidence in Tri-Valley to tackle the landscaping as they have done work for the Township before.

#### B. Update the DDA board on the sanitary sewer utility improvements planned

Rick Hopper and Trevor Schultz discussed the plans for the improvements to the sanitary sewer system. They stated how it was no cost to the Township because of a grant they were approved for which saved the Township 27 million dollars. The project will open up the sewer system for the Gratiot Road corridor.

#### C. "Buy Local" sponsorship and advertisement request

Mr. Gray presented the "Buy Local" advertisement to the board. The discussion was around how there are over \$2,000 in gift certificates to businesses that participate. This is the fourth year the TTBA has been a part of the "buy local" program. The request was that the DDA put in a \$250 advertisement for the paper that has a picture of the new landscaping at the Gateway West sign if completed before the deadline.
